Human rights are rights inherent to all human beings regardless of our nationality, place of residence, gender, identity, ethnic origin, color, religion, language or other status, serving as a basic "Code of Conduct" for all human beings.

We respect and support the International Labor Organization Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work to ensure:

- ☐ No child labor (under 18 years), No forced labor.
- ☐ Freedom of association and protection of the right to organize.
- ☐ Equal remuneration (compensation) for male and female workers for work of equal value.
- ☐ Paying wages above the minimum wage standards set by the government.
- ☐ The right to protection of occupational safety and health includes the right to rest, working hours, leave, and other provisions regulated in the Manpower Act
